Think about:

Discuss God's command to Abram to leave his home and go to a strange land. Ask the children how difficult it would be for them to leave the familiar and go somewhere strange. Examples are: leaving the familiarity of their own room to stay in a hotel while on vacation; leaving the familiarity of staying home to go to preschool for the first time; leaving the familiarity of seeing relatives to visit other people.
