November 23, 2014: Hannah and Samuel



Have each person in the family say the best part of their week and the worst part of their week.



1 Samuel 1

Summary: Hannah prayed for a son and God answered.



Do together:

Have each child write a prayer request on a slip of paper (or do it for them). Date each slip of paper and place it with the others in a jar to be prayed over all three days and in future days.

Think about:

Discuss each prayer request one. Talk about the likelihood of each request. Are they possible? Impossible? Remind the children, using Hannah as an example, that God can do anything. Like Hannah, we can put our requests before God and expect that he will do what is best.

Also read: Matthew 6:9-13



Dear Heavenly Father, we thank you for everything you have already done. Now, we set before you these simple prayer requests. To the God of the universe, these should not be difficult at all. We trust you with them and expect you will do what is best for us. So, we thank you in advance for answers. In Jesus' name, Amen.
