Matthew 28



Do together:

Write a very brief outline of the history of your family. Include those things that are important to the members of your family. Marriage, births, deaths, vacations. Emphasize that just because some of the family members may not have been present at the different occasions, they still happened. When the first child was born, the third child was not there to welcome them. That does not mean the first child did not arrive as Mom and Dad said.

Think about:

Before Jesus died, he told his friends he would rise again. Jesus' friends were not sure about this. Would it really happen? After Jesus was crucified he rose again on the third day, just like he said he would. We were not there, but we know it happened, because God told Jesus' friends to write it down, and we can read about it in the Bible.

Also read: Luke 18:31-33



Dear Jesus, we thank you that you died for our sins. We know you rose again after you died. Because you were able to do so, we can trust that all the other things you said are also true. In Jesus' name, Amen.
