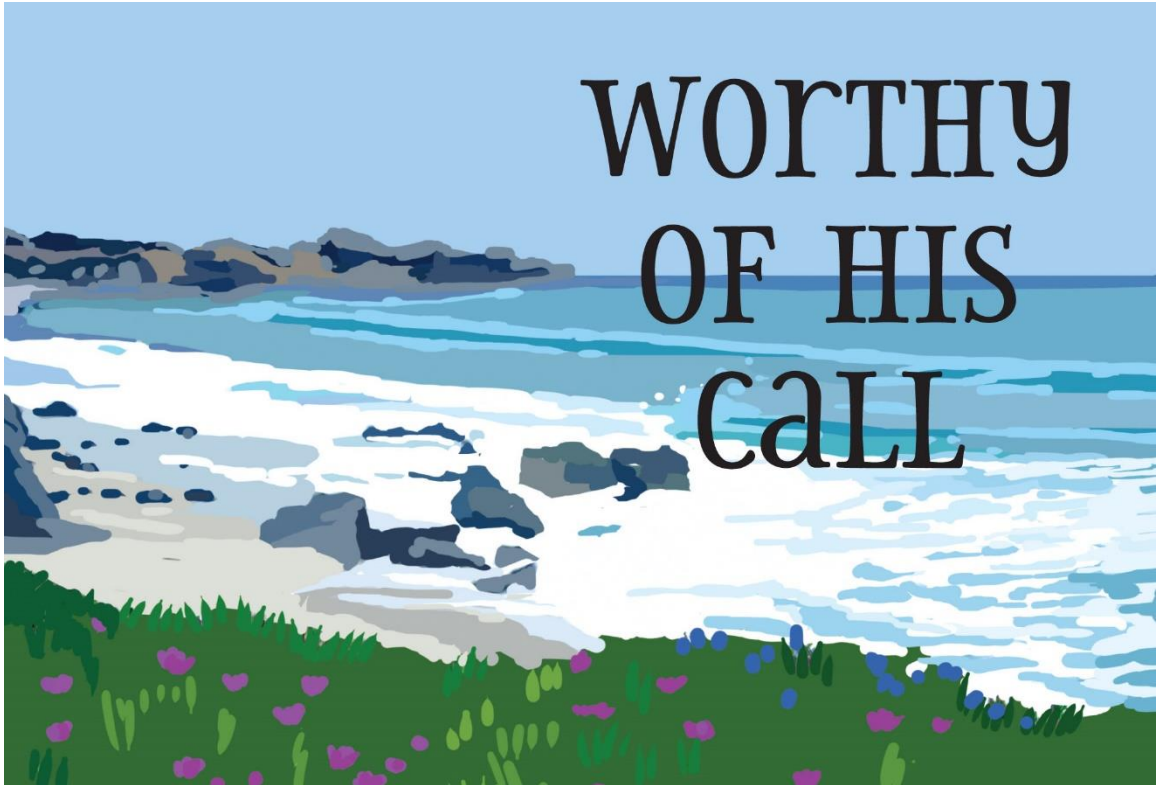

Reading: 1 Samuel 3:1-10

¹Now the boy Samuel was ministering to the LORD under Eli. The word of the LORD was rare in those days; visions were not widespread.

²At that time Eli, whose eyesight had begun to grow dim so that he could not see, was lying down in his room; ³the lamp of God had not yet gone out, and Samuel was lying down in the temple of the LORD, where the ark of God was. ⁴Then the LORD called, "Samuel! Samuel!" and he said, "Here I am!" ⁵and ran to Eli, and said, "Here I am, for you called me." But he said, "I did not call; lie down again." So he went and lay down. ⁶The LORD called again, "Samuel!" Samuel got up and went to Eli, and said, "Here I am, for you called me." But he said, "I did not call, my son; lie down again." ⁷Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, and the word of the LORD had not yet been revealed to him. ⁸The LORD called Samuel again, a third time. And he got up and went to Eli, and said, "Here I am, for you called me." Then Eli perceived that the LORD was calling the boy. ⁹Therefore Eli said to Samuel, "Go, lie down; and if he calls you, you shall say, 'Speak, LORD, for your servant is listening.'" So Samuel went and lay down in his place.

P: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God,


C: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Our Savior’s mission team is encouraging the people of Our Savior’s to use Lent as time to reflect on all God has given us. Some people “give up” something for Lent to remind them of their dependence on God and as a type of self-discipline that helps them reflect on the sacrifices Jesus made. Rather than using Lent to “give up” something, the mission team encourages you to use the 40 days of Lent to give to end hunger.

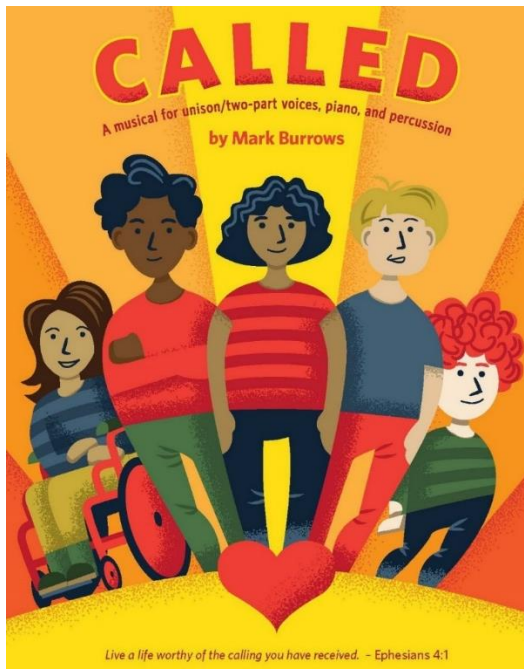
The mission team invites you to participate in the ELCA World Hunger Lent initiative “40 Day of Giving.” Our children will be receiving piggy banks for giving, and on the back table of the sanctuary is an envelope for you to place your offering. Here are some ways to think of giving during the 40 days of Lent: \$.25/day (\$10), \$2/day (\$80), \$6.25/day (\$250, which is share of a clean water project). Our *Noisy Offering* in March will also be for ELCA World Hunger.

Please make checks payable to OSLC, and write “40 Days of Giving” in the memo line. Offering may be brought to the church during Holy Week, or anytime that you would like to return the envelope.
