When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. In fact, it looks different than when I began here in 1988, and even different than just a few years ago. What is certain is that there are many who need to hear the Good News, and that we are filled with the Holy Spirit and sent to share the Good News.

Our Savior's has been blessed with many new members, baptisms, and lots of children and youth in faith formation programming. We also have hundreds of long-time members and members who are retired. We have wonderful opportunities here to grow in our discipleship and to share that with our new members, children, and youth. How can we best do that? To know the answer begins with prayer and asking God to show us the way. Then we trust God and move forward. Each of you has gifts to share, and my prayer is that each of us will use those gifts to serve God and God's people in this place (inside and outside the walls of the church). We have an opportunity and a calling to use what God has given us to share the Good News of Jesus to people wherever they are in their faith journey, and that is a privilege. Thanks be to God!
