

### **Volunteers Needed for Sunday School**

**Shepherds:** Shepherds are needed for grades 1-5. Each grade will need three shepherds to alternate during the year. The shepherds for each grade decide who will be responsible for each week. The shepherds take their group to music and the rotation each week. Your job is as a supporter. You will not do any of the teaching. You will encourage and discipline. Discipline in the rotation model is much easier than traditional Sunday School because the learning is more interactive and there are always at least two adults in the room. Remember, as a shepherd you will have no preparation work for Sunday morning! As a shepherd you will need to be available nine Sundays out of the school year.

**Rotation Leader:** Rotation leaders sign up for a five week session. There are five sessions during the year. You can sign up for one or more sessions. You sign up to lead cooking, storytelling, art, science, computer, or games. The ideas for your rotation (a teacher guide) are given to you and you plan one lesson that you teach for five weeks in a row. The kids come to you each week with a shepherd. You are responsible for the teaching and the shepherd takes care of the discipline. The rotation leader has students in grades 1-5.

## Volunteers Need for Preschool and Kindergarten

**Preschool/Kindergarten** students do a smaller version of rotation Sunday School with a new story each week. We need volunteers for three areas. Please consider how you can serve in Sunday School this year.

\_\_\_\_\_Snack Leader (plan and prepare the snacks for each week – we need four to six people for this area). There is a guide that gives you ideas for each week. This takes place the last 15 minutes of class.

\_\_\_\_\_Puppeteer (two people are needed each week - one narrator and one operating the puppet). The script is written for you.

\_\_\_\_\_Craft Leader (plan and prepare the craft for each week's story – we need four to six people for this area). There is a guide with instructions to help you each week.

## Other Volunteers Needed for Sunday School

\_\_\_\_\_I will teach **Lutheran Enrichment** in January (Grade \_\_\_\_\_). During January, students in grades 1-5 study parts of our catechism and learn about Martin Luther.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will be a **principal** for the Sunday School year. The principal helps in the Sunday School office and takes attendance.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will **enter Sunday School e-mail addresses** into the computer so we can send out Sunday School updates to parents.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will be an adult participant in **intergenerational faith talk**. This is a 15 minute commitment to talk with Sunday School students at a table about your faith memories, bible stories that are important to you, etc.
