## Faith & Books

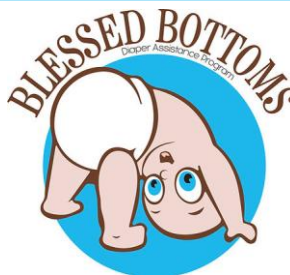
