This is our chance to describe our church community and what we are looking for in an Associate Pastor.

### ***The Annual Meeting of the Congregation of Our Savior's Lutheran Church will be held Sunday, February 2, 2025 at 10:00 A.M.***

We will have only one worship service on Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup>, at 9:00 AM.

The annual meeting will include voting for a call committee to interview and present a candidate for associate pastor. The congregation votes to extend a call after the call committee presents the candidate. We will also vote to approve the 2025 church budget, and elect members to the ministry teams.

There will be a church budget meeting on Sunday, January 26<sup>th</sup>, between services. At this meeting you will have the opportunity to discuss and ask questions about the 2025 Our Savior's church budget. **Copies of the 2024 Congregational Annual Report, including the 2025 proposed budget, will be available in the Social Hall and on our website by January 23<sup>rd</sup>.**
